

## MT1 – LT2 Task 4 Options

- 1. Political Documents Chart-** You must create a chart to symbolize **the five political documents** for LT2. You must include visuals to illustrate the **principles** provided in these documents. Be sure to provide an **explanation** of your visual.
- 2. Learner “Bill of Rights” or “Declaration”-** You must create a mock “Bill of Rights” or “Declaration” of some short for learners at LHS. You must include at least **ten** rights in your “Bill of Rights” or **four** principles in your “Declaration”. Be sure to provide an **explanation** of the “rights” or “principles” you have chosen.
- 3. Political Documents Essay-** In a well-developed essay, you must describe the **five political documents** for LT2. You must explain the impact of these documents on **democratic revolutions** and the **civil rights** they have provided for people around the world. You must use **complete sentences** in your work. Be sure to include **vocabulary words** from the LT. (At least 5 paragraphs)
- 4. Political Document Research Project-** You must conduct a research project (media or essay) in which you explore **another country** that has had a **democratic revolution**. You must explain the formation of the country’s government and any influential **political documents** that exist there. See attached table for more info. \*Possible Level 4\*
